## **30 Students Vie for Main Street Scholarships**

A total of 30 Genoa-Kingston High School seniors have “thrown their hats into the ring” seeking votes to capture scholarships worth \$1,500 sponsored by Genoa Main Street, Inc. and 25 Genoa businesses and organizations.

“Thanks to generosity and community spirit of the participating sponsors, the student garnering the most votes will receive a \$1,000 scholarship, and the runner-up will receive a \$500 scholarship, said Mim Evans, Genoa Main Street, Inc. executive director. “We are thrilled to be able to offer two scholarships this year,” she said. “Just as gratifying, is that we have 30 applicants this year.”

This is the second year the Genoa Main Street scholarship is being offered. Last year a single \$1,000 scholarship underwritten by 17 businesses attracted 12 applicants, with more than 99,000 votes cast among the candidates.

The scholarship program is designed to encourage local residents to shop and conduct business in Genoa while providing \$1,500 towards educational expenses for a graduating senior planning to attend college, community college, trade school or other “529” approved program.

Applicant’s names, photos and other information are posted at the 25 participating businesses and organizations.

Votes may be cast at any of the 15 polling places listed on the poster and below. Shoppers vote for applicants by making purchases which will be recorded by the participating business. In general, each dollar spend equals one vote. Exceptions are individual who join the Genoa-Kingston Kiwanis will be able to cast 200 votes, and individual/family donations to Genoa Main Street Inc., will receive two votes for each dollar donated.
