Genoa Community Ice Rink Now open!

Genoa's new community ice rink on North Genoa Street across from the city hall is open, ice permitting, every day until 9 pm.

Skaters should look for the red, white and blue pennants. When they are displayed, ice conditions are good enough for skating.

There is no cost to use the rink. However, since the rink is unsupervised, all skaters use the rink at their own risk.

A grand opening celebration sponsored by Citizens First National Bank will be held Saturday, January 31 starting at noon.

To encourage use of the rink Genoa Main Street, Inc. is offering a skate exchange. If you have skates you can donate, bring them to the Main Street office on the second floor of Citizens Bank. If you need skates, stop by the office or check our Web site to see what we have available (genoamainstreet.org). The skates are free!

The Genoa Community Ice Rink is a joint project of Genoa Main Street, Inc., Genoa Township Park District and the City of Genoa. The rink was funded through the generous donations of Citizens First National Bank and Stock Building Supply of Elgin and built by Main Street more than a dozen volunteers.
